Daniel TM Chan is the Chair Professor & Yu Chiu Kwong Professor in Medicine, Chief of Nephrology, Department of Medicine, University of Hong Kong.

He received training in nephrology and internal medicine in Hong Kong and at the Guy's Hospital in London, U.K.

He became Professor of Medicine at the University of Hong Kong in 1999, and was promoted to Chair Professor in 2005.

He has previously served as President of the Asian Pacific Society of Nephrology, President of the Hong Kong Society of Transplantation, Chairman of the Nephrology Board of the Hong Kong College of Physicians, Chief of Clinical Service of the Department of Medicine and Associate Dean of the LKS Faculty of Medicine at the University of Hong Kong.

HIS RESEARCH INTERESTS:

His research output has been published in the New England Journal of Medicine, Journal of the American Society of Nephrology, American Journal of Transplantation, Arthritis & Rheumatism, Gastroenterology, and Hepatology.

He is recognized for the pioneering work on the use of mycophenolate mofetil in the treatment of lupus nephritis, published in N Engl J Med in 2000.

His research impact is ranked the top 1% internationally by Essential Science Indicators.



One of his latest research interest is a randomized open-label study to evaluate the efficacy and safety of tacrolimus and corticosteroids in comparison with mycophenolate mofetil and corticosteroids in subjects with class III/IV±V lupus nephritis which is an investigator-initiated study with TM Chan as lead principal investigator for Asia Pacific and Dr. Sandra Navarra as Principal Investigator for the University of Santo Tomas University study site.
