
In celebration of its 19th Annual Scientific Meeting, the Osteoporosis Society of the Philippines Foundation Inc. hosted a 3-day

international course on bone densitometry in Acacia Hotel Manila last October 9-11, 2017. With the International Osteoporosis Foundation and the International Society for Clinical Densitometry, the

conference included 4 courses, Osteoporosis Essentials, Vertebral Fracture Recognition, Pediatric Bone Densitometry and DXA Body Composition Analysis. A choice between clinician and technologist tracks was made available to participants. OSPFI president, Dr. Julie Li-Yu, started the plenary sessions with an overview of osteoporosis. With Professor John Carey of Ireland and other esteemed clinical densitometrists, participants were led through the sessions on densitometry, diagnosis and management. Interspersing his lectures with humorous anecdotes, Prof. Carey was able to capture his audience through fast-paced though detailed discussions on the merits of uses and technical considerations in densitometry. On the afternoon of the 3rd day, onsite examination was held for clinical densitometry.
